The Unit Visit Tracking System support service provides personal assistance from an operator, along with helpful details about the UVTS system, and informative links to each section of UVTS content.

The operator is on call to answer questions from 8 a.m.–10 p.m. Monday through Saturday. If the operator is handling another UVTS call, please leave a voicemail message and they will call you back, usually within 48 hours
