No, that headline is not real. Commissioners are needed more now than ever. However that might become the news if we don't increase our ranks and provide our units with the support they need.

The retention mission of the commissioner corps is best achieved by providing an adequate number of trained unit commissioners who provide a link to district committee resources in support of a quality unit program.

In order for Scouting to thrive and the Commissioner staffs to remain relevant, we must increase the quantity and quality of Unit Commissioners. Send at least two people to the upcoming training. This is a hands-on session where each District will leave with a list of prospective Commissioners!

January 1 is right around the corner. Panicked unit leaders will be asking questions and making assumptions. It's our job to set them straight and provide accurate information. We strongly suggest:

- 1. You become familiar with the information in the resources on the National website.
- 2. Be proactive with each of your units. This could include:
 - Conduct a training at the unit's committee meeting (include parents).
 - Meet with their sponsoring organization.
 - Encourage the unit leader to review this with the youth at a meeting. Attend the meeting and be available to answer questions (or correct misinformation).
