TENURE

TRAINING

A. BCS level (Prerequisites)

- Completion of commissioner basic training.
- Completion of commissioner orientation (Commissioner Fieldbook)
- Complete courses of instruction from the Bachelor's Program level as offered by the council.
- Current Youth Protection trained.

B. MCS level

- Completion of bachelor's degree.
- Earned Arrowhead Award.
- Current registration as a commissioner.
- Complete courses of instruction from the Masters Program level as offered by the council.

C. DCS level

- Completion of master's degree.
- Current registration as a commissioner.
- Have been awarded the Commissioner's Key.
- Complete courses of instruction from the Doctor's Program level as offered by the council.
- Completion of an approved project or thesis on any topic to benefit the local council.

PERFORMANCE

- Serve on the College of Commissioner Science faculty (instructor or support staff) or work with training support for commissioners for one year.
- Recruit at least three new commissioners at any level.
- Approval of Council Commissioner or assigned Assistant Council Commissioner
- Approval of Scout Executive or Advisor to Commissioner Service
